REACH/Declaration

The REACH regulation came into force on 01 June 2007. The aim is to ensure that all substances produced and used in the EU do not have a negative impact on health and the environment. Alle manufactured and imported substances and preparations must be tested and subjected to a risk analysis if their quantity exceeds one ton per year.

At f-tronic, electrotechnical products are developed, manufactured, and distributed. If our products are used correctly, no substances are released. We do not manufacture or import any substances or preparations affected by REACH.

According to REACH, f-tronic is a "downstream user".

f-tronic is therefore not subject to any registration obligations and therefore does not have to prepare any safety data sheets.

In line with our commitment to communication along the supply chain, we are in constant contact with both our suppliers and customers.

As a manufacturer of articles within the meaning of REACH, f-tronic also fulfils its responsibility regarding information obligations on SVHC in accordance with Article 33 of the Regulation.

According to the candidate list of 17 january 2022 we can confirm that in the products requested by them, the required limit values of (<0.1%) according to the regulation will be met.

Exception after 2011/65/EU Annex III:

Lead in copper alloys (e.g. brass) up to a mass fraction of 4%.
